The Rainbow Centre was set up in 1997 as a direct response to an EU survey of deprivation across the membership of the European Union. Castle Ward in Scarborough was identified as an area with significant needs and this prompted the congregation of the Parish Church of St Mary's to act and pray.

Initial work was undertaken on a small scale with the establishment of practical support programmes based in Parish House.

Today the Centre provides an extensive range of support to those in the town of Scarborough and the wider community who are homeless or in need of other practical support.


Specialist financial and debt support is offered through Rainbow Money and the Centre recently established a furniture recycling and redistribution project providing much needed items of basic furniture to those who are being housed in the area.


In 2013 the Centre provided support to over 1300 people who were vulnerable or in difficult circumstances.


Not bad for a small charity!
